



Skyliner® Technical Bulletin 009: **Skyliner® Maintenance and Care**

The Skyliner® Fabric System is provided for a variety of uses and applications. The fabric is a woven product, which is durable and can withstand a great deal of abuse. However, there are building atmospheres/climates and chemicals that can be harmful to the liner fabric.

When the liner fabric should become dirty or have light chemical exposure, it should be cleaned with a cleaning solution of warm water and a common liquid dish detergent. Use a damp sponge or towel with the cleaning solution to wipe down the liner fabric. Chemical solvents should not be used to clean the liner fabric.

Use of a pressure washer can be used with great care. The cleaning solution mentioned above should be used. Additionally, care should be used with regard to the pressure. A distance of several feet should be used so damage of the liner fabric does not occur. It is recommended that, after pressure washing, the liner fabric be dried off.
